I thought I was on the stairway to Heaven. But, in reality, I was slipping into darkness.

Most of us seek to follow the same formula for worldly success. We investigate and put a lot of thought into factors such as the college to attend, the person to marry, the job to take, the house to buy, the community to live in, how and where to invest our money. We don't make these decisions with our heads in the sand. Yet, when it comes to looking at the condition of our soul and our relationship to God, our Creator, many people don't examine that under the same microscope, although it is of the utmost importance.

God created us to be with Him forever, in Heaven. He created us to glorify Him, to be loved by Him and to love Him. He does not want any of us to perish and He has provided the only way for us not to do so, through His Son, the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

I really didn't grasp this for many years of my life. Growing up, I thought going to church made me a good person, punching my ticket into Heaven. Then my life began to unravel in 1993. Over a period of time, God allowed me to lose pretty much everything I considered precious to me. I hit rock bottom. And it was there where I found Jesus.

I began to read the Bible. I listened daily to radio broadcasts from fundamental Christian preachers such as Roderick Caesar, Tony Evans, Jim Gent, Hank Hanegraaff, the late D. But now I have an advocate in Jesus to fight these battles with me, for He conquered all sin and death on the cross.

God picked me up and cleaned me up. He told me He loves me. He changed my heart. He changed my thinking. He gave me a new talk, a new walk and the real purpose for living. He delivered me from a lifestyle of sin. He gave me His peace and He gave me His joy. Most of all, He gave me His Son, who gave me His salvation!
